Family of Hope Mission

Family of Hope Mission Statement: We believe God has called us to help the loved ones of an addicted person.

*First: We strive for the loved ones to become closer to the Lord Jesus.

*Second: We pray for the loved ones to be freed to live a more abundant life - separate from the addicted person

*Third: We hope to help the addicted to be set free from addiction through the love of Jesus and His Word. We believe that with the abundance of our love and prayers - Love Never Fails.

Approximately eight weeks ago, Family of Hope Mission moved its meetings to Newark Faith Church. We meet on the first and third Fridays of each month, at 6pm. Family of Hope Mission is a support group for loved ones of individuals who are struggling with an addiction. We focus on not only being supportive, but also on developing and putting together a strategic plan to help the addicted person to be freed from the drugs and or alcohol. It's kind of like walking a tightrope dealing with all the difficulties and confusion of addiction. Often, family members and friends can lose hope in their loved ones' recovery. We try to restore that faith and hope in the loved ones heart. That's where healing begins and recovery can start. It is extremely important to love the addict, but not enable them. When an addict is loved, understood, and boundaries are set the loved one is freed up to live and hope. The loved one needs to understand that he or she deserves to have their life back and have peace. I have often said, "Addiction will take everything you have including your peace, job, car, house, family, friends, money, time, and even your life." The family is a big part of freedom from addiction. The love of Jesus and His Word are integrated into the meetings.

If you have a family member or friend struggling with addiction, please join us! Our group is very loving, kind, and non-judgemental. We have a good time praying, learning, talking, and eating a nice meal together.
