GREENING OF THE CHURCH

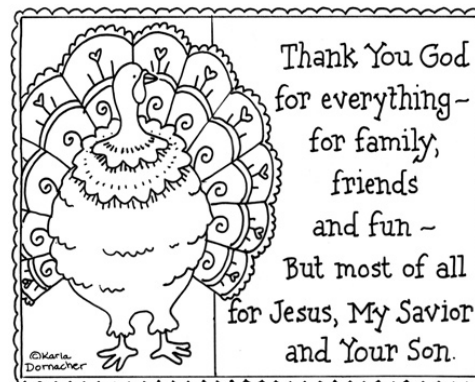
THIS Saturday at 11 am we will be Greening the church! Come on in, help the elves create the wonder of the season!
